General Dress Rehearsal Information:

1. Dress rehearsal is complete costume, hair and make-up.
2. Please see front pages for your child's/children's arrival times.
3. Parents please check your child into the cafeteria and proceed to the auditorium.
4. We will start with the finale. After the finale, we will make a few announcements and then proceed with the show in order.
5. Once students have completed all of their numbers, they may leave or watch the rest of the show.
6. No one will be allowed at the dress rehearsal except parents or guardians.
7. Videotaping is allowed at the dress rehearsal but NOT the recital.
8. Tuition MUST be paid in FULL by this time. Anyone with outstanding bills will not be allowed to participate.

Recital Ticket General Information:

1. All seats will be reserved.
2. Tickets will be \$20.00 per seat or \$35 for the whole day. (This will get you into all 4 shows)
3. If your family is participating in more than one show you only need to stand in line once. Please come to the first available show you are assigned to and purchase your tickets for the day.
4. Tickets will be sold on a first come first serve basis at a **max of 10 tickets** per family at a time. If you wish to purchase more than 10 tickets, you must wait until April 26th to purchase. This is just to ensure that everyone has an opportunity to buy tickets for their family.
5. You may **ONLY PURCHASE TICKETS FOR YOUR FAMILY.**
6. Children two years old and under are admitted free and must sit on someone's lap. If you wish to have a seat for this child, a ticket for \$20.00 must be purchased.
7. **Tickets are non refundable and are cash/check ONLY.**
8. **To avoid traffic and parking issues, you cannot line up for ticket sales until 30mins prior to ticket sale start time.**
9. There will be no phone call reservations accepted.

Picture Day General Information: ****NEW** PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

1. **Pictures will be held on Wednesday May 1st.**
2. This year picture day is by appointment **ONLY.**
3. If you wish to have a professional picture taken in your dancers costume, please see the front desk to schedule your time. Everyone will choose a 5 min time slot per costume.
4. Please schedule your professional picture **NO later than March 16th.**
5. You can choose to take pictures in ALL of your costumes or just 1. Company costumes are also an option. Each costume gets 1 time slot.
6. **Due to the lack of interest, we are not scheduling group classes for pictures this year. HOWEVER, if your class would like a group photo, please schedule time for your class at the front desk. We ask that the majority of the class be on board with this decision.**
7. Friend/sibling shots can also be scheduled at the front desk. All parents must be on board.
8. Please arrive 15min early to your scheduled picture time. All pictures will be shot on time.
9. Please do not travel in your costume. Accidents can happen.
10. Hair should be worn in a bun, except hip hop classes which should be worn in a pony tail.
11. Make-up should be light and include foundation, blush, lipstick, eye shadow and mascara.
12. NO Jewelry, nail polish or under garments should be worn with costume. This is also great practice for the stage!

General Recital Information:

1. All performers must remain at the recital until the finale. When picking-up your child at the end of the performance, you must check out with the backstage volunteer assigned to that class. This is to ensure the safety of all our dancers.
2. No jewelry, nail polish or extra hair accessories or undergarments.
3. Please do not travel to and from the dress rehearsal/recital wearing your costume as accidents can happen.
4. All costumes and accessories must be in excellent condition and no child will be allowed on stage without complete costume and recital tights.
5. Everyone must wear make-up, which includes foundation, blush, eye shadow and mascara. Due to the stage lights, which wash out faces on stage, apply make-up darker than usual.
6. Hair is to be worn in a bun with no bangs except hip hop classes which should be pony tail. If your child has short hair, we can assist you on how to get it up and away from the face.
7. No videotaping or photography of any kind (including digital) will be allowed at the recital due to the safety of the dancers and the consideration to those around you. Anyone who does not adhere to this policy will be asked to leave the auditorium. **You may videotape the dress rehearsal ONLY!** We have a videographer to record each recital. Details will follow.
8. It is customary to give flowers to dancers at the end of a performance; however, since not every student receives flowers, no flowers will be allowed on stage. Please present flowers to your child/children when they are picked up at the end of the show. There will be flowers and our CDC clothing line available for purchase in the lobby the day of the show.
9. Dancers will NOT be allowed in the audience during the recital. There will be age appropriate activities for the students waiting their turn to dance backstage.
10. Please provide a light snack for your child to have in the cafeteria while waiting for their turn to dance. NO RED juice or food that could stain. No nut products please. **ALL OF OUR RECITALS are nut free shows.**
11. There will be volunteers in the cafeteria to help with costume changes and watching over the younger classes. Please see volunteer for if you would like to be a volunteer.
'It takes a village to run a recital & any/all help is GREATLY APPRECIATED!!'
12. **For the safety of all the CDC staff & dancers, no one will be allowed back stage or in the cafeteria during the recitals who is not a volunteer or dancer. If a student needs their parent we will locate you and let you know to come backstage.**
13. All tuition must be paid in **FULL** by May 15th, (unless on auto pay through June) 2019 in order for your child/children to participate in the recital.
14. No classes will be held during the week of the recital (May 13th-18th). We will be having 1 week of regular classes after the recital.
15. Please inform your guests to be on time and remain in their seats during the show. The doors to the lobby will only open at the usher's discretion and we do not want you to miss any of your numbers.
16. As per Milford recreation department policies, there will be no food or drinks allowed in the auditorium at any time. Anyone who does not adhere to this policy will be asked to leave the auditorium at once. If CDC does not adhere to these policies, we will no longer be allowed to rent any further facilities for any other function.
17. Please be courteous to those seated around you and especially to those on stage.
18. Please choose wisely when purchasing your assigned seat/ticket. We will have your child's basic stage position posted for all Tiny Dancers I, Tiny Dancers II, Junior combo I, II & III classes. Please ask your child and/or your child's teacher where they would recommend the best place would be to purchase a ticket for beginner levels and up. If your child is in more than once dance it will be hard to find the "perfect" seat from all angles. Please note: No one will be allowed to stand in the audience if they cannot see their child. Please be respectful and stand to the side or in the back in between numbers if you think you may have trouble seeing. Anyone who does not adhere to this policy will be asked to leave the auditorium.
